

Our Lady of Guadalupe: Mother of the Civilization of Love

- by Carl Anderson & Eduardo Chavez (Anderson who also wrote Called to Love: Approaching John Paul II's Theology of the Body - along with Jose Granados)

The authors provide an excellent description of the events of the apparitions, the miracle of the painting, as well as an overview of the historical events and conditions of the times. They provide an intriguing insight into the meaning of the colours and symbols of the miraculous painting on St Juan Diego's tilma or cloak.

Although the full significance of Guadalupe may never be known, Anderson and Chavez do a brilliant job of showing us that the message of the event is becoming clearer, that its applicability today is even though different, is no less meaningful as it was at the time.

In the painting Our Lady appears as a mestiza, a person of mixed blood from both European and Indian blood. This and other aspects of the painting shows the inclusion of both the Spanish and the Indians as equals.

The designs on the tilma also show her desire for the people and government to move away from the human sacrifices and war, to a complete respect for life. During one of his four visits to the shrine, Pope John Paul II entrusted the cause of life to our lady, and placed under her care the lives of those who are in danger of not being born.

"Our Lady of Guadalupe's apparition can only be understood fully now, when Catholicism's most expressed model for society is a Civilization of Love and its greater explication of human dignity is the Theology of The Body." In the book, the authors stress the importance of love as relationship, as in making a gift of oneself to others, as opposed to love being a physical act. "If we are to see in her {Mary's} words an answer to a spiritual problem, the spiritual problem it answers is a lack of love and a lack of understanding about love as a relationship rather than as a practice."

CARL ANDERSON, New York Times bestselling author, is the chief executive officer and chairman of the board of the Knights of Columbus. He held various positions of the Executive Office of the President from 1983 to 1987, was a member of the U.S. Commission on Civil Rights, and has taught at the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family.

FATHER EDUARDO CHAVEZ is one of the most renowned experts on the Guadalupe apparitions and the postulator of St. Juan Diego's cause for sainthood. He is the first Dean of the Catholic University Lumen Gentium of the Archdiocese of Mexico, co-founder and Dean of the Higher Institute for Guadalupan Studies and honorary Canon of the Guadalupe Basilica

Peter's Points to Ponder

What is the most common reaction for a teenager who's told "Don't do that" with little explanation as to the consequences of doing what they're not supposed to do, or the explanation given is "because I said so"? It's human nature to want to do what you're not supposed.

In 1953, Hugh Hefner launched the first edition of "Playboy", and the 1960s are commonly referred to as the "sexual revolution". During this time, there was an increase in pornography and the advent of oral contraception (birth control pill). With the exception of Pope Paul VI's encyclical "Humane Vitae", the church was fairly quiet on these issues. Pope Paul's encyclical addressed the dignity of human life, and birth control; however, it did not provide the theology behind the Church's teachings. The controversial encyclical was, for many, especially in the Western World, seen as the "just don't do it" encyclical. It's safe to assume that many who criticized this encyclical had also never read it in full.

Pope John Paul II knew the importance of emphasizing "don't do it", but recognized the Church's teachings lacked the required explanation. In response, he released his "Theology of the Body" starting September 10, 1979, with the 1st of 129 General Audiences which would last until December 3, 1984. In this rich body of work, John Paul II teaches that the body is created in the image and likeness of God, and, as such, must be used as God designed it to be used. When seen in its entirety, John Paul II's "Theology of the Body" truly is the answer to the ever popular question "What is the meaning of life?"
