



GREEN BAY, Wis. (December 8, 2010) — Bishop David Ricken announced today that he officially approves the Marian apparitions at the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help at Champion.

The announcement was made during a special Mass for the Feast of the Immaculate Conception at the Shrine of Our Lady of Good Help at Champion.

Declared with moral certainty

Reading from his decree, the Bishop stated, "I declare with moral certainty and in accord with the norms of the Church that the events, apparitions and locutions given to Adele Brise in October of 1859 do exhibit the substance of supernatural

opening before the Church like a vast ocean upon which we shall venture...On this journey we are accompanied by the Blessed Virgin Mary..."" Today's declaration makes Our Lady of Good Help at Champion the first and only site in the United States of an approved apparition of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

Uniting Theology Of Body With Theology Of Love



In memoriam - Rev. Richard Hogan (1952-2011)

"Anyone who has seriously studied the Theology of the Body knows the name of Rev. Richard Hogan. He co-authored Covenant of Love with Fr. John LeVoir, the first commentary book in English on this series of addresses by then-Pope John Paul II. He was recognized last summer with a Distinguished Achievement award as a pioneer in the advancement of the teaching of the Theology of the Body at the first ever Theology of the Body Congress.

Fr. Hogan spent many years teaching and preaching on the TOB and Natural Family Planning. He worked for several years with NFP Outreach, giving parish missions all over the country. He served on CCL's Board of Directors for three years, and was the primary person responsible for infusing our new course with a TOB focus. 



Peter's Points to Ponder



A Catholic Rap Singer Fr. Stan Fortuna suggested in one of his songs that the word FAMILY is actually an acronym for "Forget About Me, I Love You". For a "family" to be a family in the truest sense of the word, it must be centered in Love, and for "love" (a commonly used but often misunderstood word) to be true "Love" it must be a selfless, self-giving love. The core of the family starts with the parents, whose mutual love for each other brings forth new life. This new life then demands a complete self-giving of the couple by providing the basic human needs (food, water, love, clean diapers, etc).

The love of the couple sustains both their own relationship, and the child; by giving everything of themselves the couple is enriched, and receive from God, and their spouse what is needed.

It is true that love demands a great deal, and it does require that each person forget about themselves (their own selfish needs and desires) to focus on what is best for the couple as a whole, but in so doing they receive much more in return. The couple who loves one another also realizes that they forget about themselves not because love demands this; they forget about themselves because they love the other, and want to do what is best for their partner.
