"Is birth control morally acceptable?"	Christians and Birth Control, Part 1, by Stephanie Gray When I present about abortion, I'm sometimes asked about birth control. There are those who think that if one is against abortion one should surely be in favor of birth control; after all, wouldn't increasing the latter decrease the former? Actually it does not, as I address here. I think a more fundamental question, though, is not "Will birth control decrease or increase abortion?" but rather, "Is birth control morally acceptable?" That came up at a recent presentation I gave at a Christian church in my home city of Vancouver, Canada. This topic is often framed as a Catholic-Protestant debate, with the Catholic church teaching contraception is morally wrong and many Protestant churches accepting some forms of contraception. This difference, however, is a new phenomenon. And by "new" I mean the last 90 years. The history of churches of various denominations claiming to follow Christ for the previous 2,000 years has been one where contraception has been rejected—until the Anglicans first embraced it in 1930. I therefore believe a solid, Biblical case can be made for objecting to birth control—appealing to all people who claim to follow Christ, regardless of denominational differences. 

While we hear less about it in a secularized Church, everybody knows the traditional emphasis is always just beneath the surface. This is so obvious to outsiders that the Church has often been accused of not really caring about any other kind of sin. That's not true, of course. But the barest whiff of Catholic emphasis on sins of the flesh is enough to send the world into paroxysms of denunciation.

Sexual Re-connection

To see that the Sexual Revolution has been radical in thought as well as behavior, just look at the revolution in language. When people use the word "morality" today they almost always mean sexual morality. That's a remarkable new development, an astonishing narrowing; it's as if we started to use the word "state" to mean only Russia, or the word "technology" to mean only "computers". The reason for the new development is obvious from my two comparisons: sex, Russia, and computers are where there have been the most radical revolutions.

No one speaks of a revolution in any other area of morality. No one speaks of the Property Revolution or the Bearing False Witness Revolution. In fact the rest of the natural moral law is pretty much still in place. Almost no one defends terrorism, sadism, cannibalism, insider trading, nuclear war, environmental pollution, rape, hypocrisy, torture, or murder. We are still "judgmental" about those things. But if it has anything to do with sex we dare no longer be "judgmental".

First, Mary Bastedo got to know Jesus through the L'Arche community. As a result, she followed a call to celibacy – not through a religious order, but rather, through the **Order of Consecrated Virginity**.

Bastedo is one of 10 women in the Archdiocese of Toronto who has been consecrated to the *Ordo Virginuum* since the first local consecration in 1983. Across Canada, about 50 women are following this call, says Bastedo, who assists locally with the formation and discernment process for women contemplating this ecclesial vocation. France and Italy have the highest number of vocations to the order, with 620 and 600 respectively.

Celebrating the Courage of Blessed Pope Paul VI

Talk by Christopher West on Humanae Vitae

July 25, 2018, marks 50 years since Pope Paul VI shocked the world when he issued his encyclical letter Humanae Vitae (Of Human Life) reaffirming the traditional Christian teaching against contraception. Although he was mocked and scorned globally – both from outside and, sadly, from within the Church – his words were prescient. He warned that a contracepting world becomes a world of rampant infidelity; a world where women and childbearing are degraded; a world in which governments trample on the rights and needs of the family; and a world in which human beings believe they can manipulate their bodies at will (see HV 17).




