We thought therefore, that we would lay out our plan to use this program in a classroom setting in an effort to demonstrate how easy it is, especially for professionals to teach this in their classroom. This is the format which we used successfully recently at Father Leo Austin High School in Whtiby

The Plan

Theology of the Body for Teens is divided into 12 chapters and is full of ideas and resources. We have adapted the **Guide to the Leader's Guide** (A tool to help navigate the Leader's Guide) from the resources at http://thetheologyofthebody.com/download/category/18. Our Guides (aka Our Agendas) can be found on our website at: http://www.godsexandthemeaningoflife.com/ToBforTeens-Agendas.html
These guides lay out our weekly teaching plans for using the ToB for Teens

These guides lay out our weekly teaching plans for using the ToB for Teens books, provide resources and ideas, and are a valuable tool enabling any teacher to introduce this wonderful teaching into the classroom.

- 1. We are able to meet with you or discuss with you any part of this plan, including ideas, resources and materials. The following is a sample weekly guide for a lesson of 75 minutes:
 - a. Bible Reading & Prayer: Start with a Bible Reading, followed by a prayer (This mirrors JPII's approach in the ToB). These readings and prayers are found at the beginning of each chapter and usually involve 2 student volunteers. There are always two different choices for the readings and prayer and both are reflected in the lesson for the day (the current chapter).
 - b. Two Minute Drill: This is a 2 minute drill based on the previous chapter and serves as a review. The questions and answers are both included in the Leader's Guide, so there is no need to search through the content for the answers. Quickly review the questions before asking them to ensure they deal with topics that you actually covered in the previous week.
 - c. **Ice Breaker:** If possible, do an "ice-breaker". This is an activity that the students will enjoy. "Ice-breakers" are found in the Leader's Guide along with the rationale and point to make upon doing the tasks. These activities are fun and usually the students grasp the teaching point quickly once explained to them.
 - d. **Story Starter:** Read the Introduction and Story Starter we usually have students take turns reading the paragraphs, then discuss some or all of the questions after the reading.
 - e. **DVD Presentation:** Next we watched the DVD segment for that chapter. At this time, Jason & Crystalina & Brian summarize some of the other content from the chapter. As there is not enough time in the class to go over all of the material in the chapter, watching the DVD is more efficient. When the DVD talk is over, a short ToB Quiz starts. The students look forward to these quizzes, often calling out the answers. They have to pay attention to the talk to get the answers.
 - f. **Teaching:** Sometimes we would have a teaching, for example, in Chapter one, we asked them for things that are real but invisible to the naked eye. We listed their suggestions on the board. This was to help the students understand how our bodies act as visible signs of the invisible. This point is further explained on p. 11L in the Leader's Guide
 - g. Movie Clips: We tried to use some of the present culture to support a point from the lesson. For example, we would show a clip of a current movie (and these were very short clips) to make a point that further illustrated the main teaching of the chapter. Lists of movie choices, along with song choices, are found in the Leader's Guide near the end of each chapter. Each clip has a point to make and these points are included.

- h. **Closing Prayer:** We concluded with a prayer, found at the end of each chapter. For example, at the end of Chapter Four, there is prayer to St. Elizabeth Ann Seton p. 65. In the Leader's Guide on p. 65L, there is a short summary of that particular saint's life, which we read before we said the prayer.
- i. Crossword: At the end of each lesson, there is a Glossary of Key Terms. We provided a crossword to help the students become familiar with these new terms, or the students could make their own using one of the many crossword making programs online for example we use http://www.eclipsecrossword.com/
- j. Extra Material: While the above material covered the 75 minute period, we were always prepared with more. The *Live It Out* section near the end of each chapter is very useful either to be read during class or after.
- k. **Assignments**: While we would usually just assign the Crossword, there are many suggested assignments at the end of each chapter.

Blessed John Paul II's "theology of the body" provides a new way of navigating within parish catechesis precisely because it provides a new language, a rich, sacramental language expressed through a sacramental anthropology, that can inform all of our catechesis from womb to tomb and thus be an effective tool for passing on the deposit of the faith to modern-day man immersed in a post-modern culture. Without this rich sacramental language, we can't think sacramentally. And if we can't think sacramentally, then we can't choose sacramentally; and if we can't choose sacramentally then we really can't love because human love, in its deepest essence is sacramental: it makes visible the invisible mystery hidden from eternity in God.





Rome Talk November 10, 2011 Chastity and the Gift of Self By Fr. Walter Schul

"For freedom Christ has set us free" (Gal 5:1).

Freedom of the Gift

John Paul II uses the word "freedom (*libertà*)" 93 times in his theology of the body.¹³ It is a crucial term in his understanding of who we are as persons and what constitutes the meaning of our existence. Freedom culminates in what the Holy Father calls the "freedom of the gift (*libertà del dono, libertà di dono*)."¹⁴ The capacity to give oneself entirely to another person reveals "the innermost point" of freedom (TOB 18, 5).

The fact that freedom possesses an "innermost point" already makes it clear that it is not a question of an absolute freedom of indifference, given to us all at once, but of a freedom that must be forged and developed, one that must be conquered through self-mastery and growth in virtue. John Paul II specifically defines what is denoted by his concept of freedom: "Here we mean freedom above all as *self-mastery* (self-dominion). Under this aspect, self-mastery is indispensable *in order for man to be able to "give himself,"* in order for him to become a gift..." (TOB 15, 2). Freedom in its true form as freedom for excellence underlies the entire theology of the body. Read the whole talk...click here

fictional story-line as factual, often times leaving viewers confused. Could the events in the movie really be true?

I would like to focus in particular on the Dan Brown movies that suggest that Jesus was married. Could it be true, was Jesus married? After all, the Bible doesn't explicitly say Jesus wasn't married. The reality is, we need look no further then the Bible to understand that Jesus could not have been married. While on the cross, Jesus said to the apostle John "Behold your mother." (John 19:27), and he goes no further in leaving his loved ones to the care of others. In Genesis 2:24 we read "For this reason, a man shall leave behind his father and mother, and he shall cling to his wife; and the two shall be as one flesh." Based on this, Jesus recognizes that the marital relationship is the deepest and most intimate of all human relationships.

Jesus also recognized the pain associated with death, as witnessed by the tears shed for his friend Lazarus (John 11:35), and the Sermon on the Mount where Jesus said "Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be consoled." (Matthew 5:5) Knowing

Had Jesus been married, he could not have allowed his mother to take a more dominant position at his own passion and death then a woman to whom he was married.
