Sexual Revolution is a well-made, thought-provoking documentary. It has a stellar list of contributors including Archbishop Charles J. Chaput, Dr. Peter Kreeft, Mary Eberstadt, Christopher West, Abby Johnson, Dr. Janet Smith, alongside archive footage of Drs. John & Evelyn Billings and St. Mother Teresa. The film traces the personal history of a young woman's search for the truth about human sexuality, but it is also a social history, a secret history if you like, of much that is wrong in our society.

In the opening shots of *Sexual Revolution*, you could be forgiven for thinking that you had stumbled into the wrong movie. # After 25 years, what JP2's Letter to Families can teach today's world

Denver, Colo., Jan 30, 2019 / 04:05 am (CNA).- Pope John Paul II was born Karol Wojtyla, a man from a small town in Poland who lost all of his immediate family - mom, older brother, an infant sister, and father - by the time he was 20 years old. Shortly thereafter, he vowed a life of celibacy as a Catholic priest. And yet, Wojtyla would go on to be remembered as "Pope of the Family."

25 years ago next week, on Feb. 2, 1994, Pope John Paul II penned his "Letter to Families," the subject of which was spurred by the United Nations' declaration that 1994 would be the "Year of the Family."

for our own selfish desires. So I think John Paul was already recognizing that the foundation of society itself is already in jeopardy, if people are not getting married, if they're not having kids. They're saying no to the future."

At the time, U.S. divorce rates were higher - about 4.6 per 1,000 people, compared with 2.9 in 2017. But marriage rates were also higher - 9.1 compared with 6.9 for those same years. Legalized same-sex marriage was still considered a taboo political idea, and would remain so for more than a decade. And Bruce Jenner still went by Bruce Jenner.

But even though it was written 25 years ago, many Catholics in family life ministries believe that the Church is only beginning to see the fruits of John Paul II's message to families.

# Human Physicality and the Near Occasion of Sin

"Pornography, as well as puritanism, are both deeply flawed visions of the human body.

Is it possible to display an image of a human form in such a way that it is not to be construed as simply a near occasion of sin? From Michelangelo's

'David' to Bernini's 'St. Teresa in Ecstasy', erotic presentations of the human form are not necessarily intended to be pornographic, but rather are ways to express the body as a divine gift. The sculpture of David invites the viewer to envision more than just a body, rather it represents the body of the young Israelite as an expression of the status of the human person as being made in the image and likeness of God. Bernini's 'St. Teresa in Ecstasy' suggests that her body is not something leading her away from divine union, but instead it is to be understood as the intertwining of erotic gratification and agape devotion as the height of mystical experience. It seems today that in both of these types of displays, we find what pornography and Puritanism both lack: an integration of the eros and agape that fulfills the divine purpose for the body."



The young newlywed put herself at risk for collapse, stroke, heart attack, and death every day when she popped her birth control pill. Tragically, she had no idea there was any danger. Even medical personnel thought her symptoms were no big deal, and on more than one occasion chalked her symptoms up to dehydration. They never told her it could be that her contraception was causing blood clots.
