

I. "REMEDY OF CONCUPISCENCE" IN TRADITION

Since 1983 the Church's magisterium has expressed the ends of marriage as two: procreation, and the good of the spouses. Much has been written about this, especially as to the omission of the former, hierarchical concept: primary and secondary ends. My own analysis is that the Church, rather than any hierarchy of ends, now wishes to emphasise their intimate connection and interdependence, especially so as to help overcome the modern mindset that marriage can be truly fruitful and "fulfilling" independently of the children who may be born of and nourish any genuine conjugal love. Here I wish simply to draw conclusions from the apparent disappearance of the former two "secondary ends", the mutuum adiutorium and the remedium concupiscentiae.



Peter's Points to Ponder

The Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI has declared that a "Year of Faith" will run from October 11, 2012 – November 24, 2013. The "Year of Faith" is meant to celebrate the 50th anniversary of the opening of Second Vatican Council, and the 20th anniversary of the Catechism of the Catholic Church.

The US Conference of Catholic Bishops have stated that the "The upcoming Year of Faith is an opportunity for every Catholic to turn towards Jesus Christ, encounter him in the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist and rediscover the Faith and Church".

In his announcement "Porta Fidei" Pope Benedict XVI writes the "door of faith is always open". In saying that the door is always open the Holy Father reminds us that Jesus is always waiting for us, and we must approach the door. Jesus doesn't come and drag us into a relationship with him, he invites us; but ultimately the accepting response is ours to give.

As laity we are called to participate in the New Evangelization, and in order to do this we must be able to communicate the mission of the Church. Blessed John Paul II's "Theology of the Body" could be one starting point for better understanding the mission of the Church. 

Don't condemn their current or past choices. Our culture embraces contraception as something we are entitled to, a basic right. They may be choosing contraception because they don't know that there is another way.

Do let them know they have other options. Most women just don't know about NFP and what they do know about it probably isn't accurate. Correct their misinformation and let them know what the truth is in the most charitable way possible. Don't leave them hanging if they decide to switch to NFP. Making that leap of faith to ditch the pill can be terrifying. Learning a new method, potentially abstaining for a cycle or two, and the anxiety that comes with the "two week wait" can have a major effect on couples. Do check up on them. Check back in with them, let them know you're there to listen and to offer them encouragement.

Our Ministry is approved by The Archdiocese of Toronto and has presented over thirty Workshops on Pope John Paul II's Theology of the Body in Parishes in the Toronto Archdiocese. As well, in the fall of 2009, we organized and held a Theology of the Body Conference in Toronto. This conference was attended by over 1000 people. At the same time, we facilitated a Luncheon meeting on this same topic for Priests and Seminarians with over 120 in attendance. We have held eight Theology of the Body for Teens workshops and have been invited into four high schools to provide a session on the Theology of the Body in the Classroom. We have also held workshops for Parents.
