Our ministry has presented over thirty Workshops on the *Theology of the Body* in many Parishes in the Toronto and Hamilton Archdioceses. As well, in the fall of 2009, we organized a Conference attended by over 1000 people. At the same time, we facilitated a Luncheon meeting on this same topic for Priests and Seminarians with over 120 in attendance.

We have held over eight *Theology of the Body for Teens* workshops and have been invited into many high schools to provide a session on the *Theology of the Body in the Classroom*. We have also held workshops for Parents.

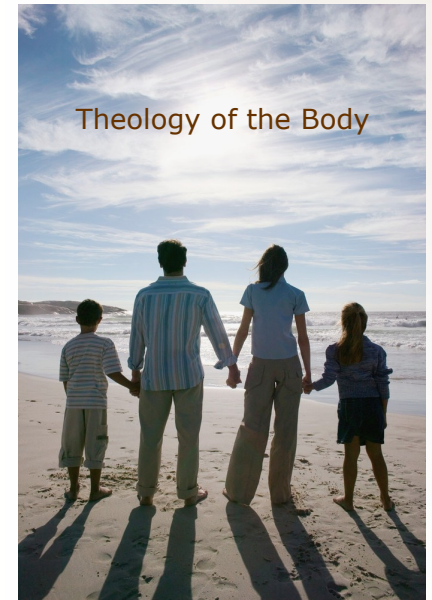

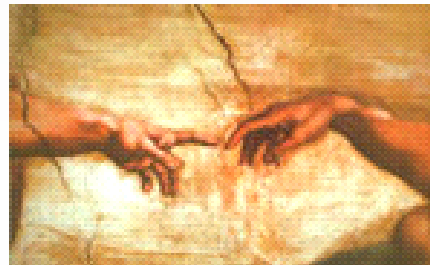
Topics Include:
