God, Sex and the Meaning of Life Ministry, (GSML Ministry) was formed in 2006. Our ministry has presented over thirty Workshops on the *Theology of the Body* in many Parishes in the Toronto and Hamilton Archdioceses. As well, in the fall of 2009, we organized a Conference attended by over 1000 people. At the same time, we facilitated a Luncheon meeting on this same topic for Priests and Seminarians with over 120 in attendance. We have held twenty *Theology of the Body for Teens* workshops and have been invited into three high schools to facilitate 12 sessions on the *Theology of the Body for Teens* (4 classes per day). We have also held workshops for Parents. Our Ministry is approved by The Archdiocese of Toronto.

Our Workshops

God, Sex and the Meaning of Life Workshop: This workshop, for married couples, singles and celibates, male and female, young and old, is based on Christopher West's DVD talks in which he unpacks Pope John Paul II's teachings, translating them into language everyone can understand. It explores the connection between sex and the questions of human existence.

Theology of the Body for Teens: This program takes the two hottest topics on the planet—God and sex—and "marries" them through Pope John Paul II's compelling vision for love and life. This workshop, for teens and young adults, is a positive portrayal of our sexuality as a good and essential part of love and life. During 12 weekly sessions, which include activities appropriate to the age group, participants discover the beauty and purpose of their sexuality, and why it is such a major part of their ability to love.

Theology of the Body for Grade 6, 7 & 8: This program answers the questions young teens may have about sexual morality, relationships, and how they were uniquely created for greatness. It uses a dynamic mix of stories, real-life examples, activities, prayers, and relevant references to the culture, all packed into eight life-changing lessons.

Theology of the Body & Confirmation: Our workshop on Confirmation combines the teachings of Pope John Paul II on the "language of the body" in his Theology of The Body, with the Catholic Church's teachings on confirmation. The goal of the workshop for those approaching confirmation is to reinforce the teaching on the Gifts of The Holy Spirit and the good that comes from them, and how we act them out in the language of our bodies to live a life of chastity. We hope the youth will take this workshop to heart, as the benefits are enormous. Modesty, dignity, reduced chance of pregnancy, less chance of abortion – in other words, all of the good things parents would want for their child.

Guiding Your Child Through The Sexual Minefield: From Toddlers To Teens: Do your kids tune you out? Regardless of the ages of our children, as parents, we have the daily duty to be involved in moulding their morality and ethics in a Catholic way. It is no longer enough to leave the task to the schools. We must counteract the false messages about love that are rampant in our culture. This presentation will

provide parents with tools to help them mould the morals and sexuality of children from toddlers to teens.

Theology of the Body in the Classroom: Our ministry was delighted to be invited to participate in Respect For Life Week by the Toronto Catholic District School Board. We provide a brief introduction to the Theology of the Body for Teens—suitable for one classroom period. The session can be expanded to cover more of the topic.

Training Presentation Skills and Basic Theology of the Body: This workshop will assist participants in organizing and facilitating workshops, making effective use of the microphone and PowerPoint presentations, as well as in running group discussions. Participants will also be offered the opportunity to practice their skills at any of our Workshops including Theology of the Body for Teens.

Parish Retreat / Workshop: An all day retreat suited for all ministries and staff in a parish to enable those in the Ministry to integrate the Theology of the Body into their ministries and daily activities.

About our Workshops

- Workshops are led by trained facilitators
- Facilitator-led small discussion groups

- Multi-Session workshops can be full day, half days, or weekly for several weeks
- Can serve as Lenten Retreat
