During Lent, the Church unites with Christ on a journey towards the glory of His resurrection. We follow Christ to the mountain and, with the apostles, witness the Transfiguration. We stand among the crowds on the street, waiving palm branches joyfully welcoming him to the city, then later, standing by as he is arrested. Then, again we line the streets, this time as Jesus walks by carrying a cross on which he will be crucified and die for our salvation.

The "Theology of the Body" can also be a journey united with Christ if we let the words of John Paul II echo within the depths of our hearts. We see more clearly the consequences of the original fall; but, we learn that Jesus came to redeem us, to teach us God's original plan for life and love.
