2009 in Review

2009 has been an eventful year!

We started to prepare for the Theology of the Body Conference early in 2009 sending posters and information to all the parishes in Southern Ontario and Western New York. On top of our preparatory work, we held a Lenten workshop at St. Boniface in Scarborough and a full day workshop for the Bukas Loob sa Diyos Covenant Community. We also ran a Theology of the Body for Teens at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish in Toronto with the help of a number of Youth Leaders. During Respect for Life Week in Toronto, we were invited to present the ToB in the Classroom to grade nine and grade ten classes.

After the Conference, we had a full day workshop at St. Theresa's Parish in Scarborough. Two weeks later, we held our first workshop in Hamilton at St. Margaret Mary with over 60 people attending. It was a powerful workshop and there was considerable interest in the ToB. We also held our first full day ToB for Teens Workshop at St. Nicholas Bari. We are thankful to God to have these opportunities to present the Theology of the Body.

"Much attention has been given to John

Paul's Theology of the Body in recent years. Few, however, realize that this five-year catechetical series the Holy Father began shortly after his election was aimed precisely at undergirding and explaining the teachings of Humanae Vitae. The first major teaching of John Paul's pontificate, in fact, was this series of papal catecheses given in his Wednesday audiences in the Pope Paul VI Hall between September 1979 and November 1984. These 129 lectures, known collectively as the "Theology of the Body," were divided into "cycles" and culminated in the sixth and final cycle devoted to a study of Humanae Vitae and its teaching on responsible parenthood and the regulation of birth."... 
MOTHERING - FULL OF GRACE MOTHERS' GROUP:

ToB Among Evangelicals

Interest in the ToB among Evangelicals is growing. Chris Carter a teacher of theology and ethics at an evangelical college in Canada attended the Theology of the Body Conference. In a recent class on marriage, he had his students read *Man and Woman He Created Them: A Theology of the Body* by John Paul II. He relates the **effect it had on his students**:

"They were mostly surprised to be reading a biblicaltheological study by a Roman Catholic that seemed to them to be informed by a high view of Scriptural authority and a deep engagement with the text. They found him to be Evangelical in his view and very convincing.

By the end of the class about half were convinced that artificial contraception is wrong and most of the rest were very open to the idea of Natural Family Planning. All found John Paul II's arguments to be impressive and not to be dismissed lightly. In fact, I have arranged for a speaker from [the Billings Ovulation Method] to come to campus on Feb. 4 to make a presentation on the practical questions surrounding NFP.

My experience is that the problem is simply ignorance. Evangelicals and Roman Catholics live in "two solitudes" and communication is bad. Christopher West, who has devoted his life to spreading the message of TOB, was in Toronto for a conference in [Oct.] and I attended with about 8 of my current and former students. It was quite an experience to be in such a heavily Catholic environment. (We even attended the 8 am Mass with Archbishop Thomas Collins as homilist and main celebrant and, no, we did not communicate.).

But John Paul II is bigger than Roman Catholicism, if I might be permitted to put it that way. He represents the Tradition and he also represents the apostolic message of Scripture as the fount of that Tradition. I have a student doing an honours thesis this year on how John Paul II's TOB differs from the teaching of St. Augustine, which is a very interesting topic. The TOB is for the whole church. I believe it is a gift given by God now for the post-sexual revolution Church in the West and I agree with George Weigel's famous prediction that it is a time bomb set to go off some time in the third millennium with great blessings for the entire world."

A Rose by Any Other Name: Part 2

In the April 23, 2009 edition of the *Globe & Mail* there was a Question & Answer article written about an interview with Sharlene Azam, author of "Oral Sex Is The New Goodnight Kiss".

This article highlights what should be of great concern to our society, teenage prostitution. The young girls involved in these prostitution rings are "swapping sex for ... just about anything". Of even greater concern than the behavior of these young girls, is the fact that "none of the girls, not even the recruiters, are willing to call what they do prostitution, even when cash is exchanged. They say 'hooking up' and 'one-night stands". As a society, we need to recognize that these kinder, more gentle words make the behavior sound more acceptable, but they in no way change the harmful effects these behaviors have on the individuals, and society as a whole.

So what lures these girls to teenage prostitution? Ms. Azam argues "that father absenteeism, ineffectual sexual education classes, Internet porn, a hypersexual 'poisonous culture' that promises status through the accumulation of luxury goods" are to blame.

So is this a problem only for our young girls? NO! "[The boys] have this idea of what sexy is and it's a total fabrication. It has nothing to do with girls that they know, but it's really influencing how they treat girls. They will have an inability to relate to a girl in a normal, healthy relationship." In short, the boys need to learn not to treat these girls as objects.

Unfortunately, this behavior is an endless circle of degradation. The sexual problems of today's teens will have a huge impact on the teens of tomorrow. If this problem isn't solved, the teens of today will have a problem relating to each other in a normal healthy sexual relationship (marriage). The further breakdown in marriage leads to more single parent families. The Globe & Mail article points out that "nearly all of the girls were living with single Moms". As the Holy Father, Pope John Paul II, writes in his *The Gospel of Life*, "the trivialization of sexuality is among the principal factors which have led to contempt for new life."
