



Mary Magdalene was at first unable to recognize the Risen Lord on Easter Morning. It wasn't until he spoke and called her "Mary!" that she recognized Him. *John 20: 14-15* Jesus' body is now somehow very different, yet also very much the same. His Body still bares the marks of his Crucifixion, but he can now appear to the disciples even though the doors are locked. *John 20: 26-27*

The Authentic Catholic Woman by Genevieve Kineke is a profound yet practical guide, inviting women to consider the Church, the Bride of Christ, as the model for authentic Catholic womanhood. What does it mean to be a woman today? Is there a one-size-fits-all answer? How can a woman be truly Catholic and truly feminine, hardworking and creative, and yet be at peace within? How does she nurture life at home, at school, on the job or in the culture?

The author explores facets of this mystery – the Church as mother, bride, spouse and teacher, as sacramental, as font of wisdom, source of culture and life-giving sanctuary – and reveals how women mirror the Church in their core identity. As Pope John Paul II said, 'The mission of women is inscribed in the mystery of the Church'.

Did You Know?

That Christopher West was involved in the second translation in English of Pope John Paul II's Theology of The Body? In the forward to Christopher West's book *Theology of the Body Explained*, which carries the Imprimatur of Sean Cardinal O'Malley, O.F. M. Cap Archbishop of Boston 2007 Michael Waldstein, theologian and author wrote:

"IN JUNE 2005 WHEN I HAD completed the first draft of the new translation of John Paul II's theology of the body, I contacted Christopher West because I had learned about his many years of intensive experience in teaching the theology of the body to various audiences at universities, seminaries, parishes, etc. An intensive exchange of e-mails followed (more than a hundred) in which he helped me to hammer out formulations, to make them clearer and more communicable. In many instances he persuaded me to go back to the phrasing of the original English translation published in L'Osservatore Romano, substantial passages of which he had memorized and held dear; in other instances I persuaded him of new proposed formulations; in yet others we reached a third formulation that neither of us had originally thought of. It is a joy for me to express my gratitude for this fruitful collaboration.

An initially unexpected fruit of our collaboration was West's decision to revise his *Theology of the Body Explained* on the basis of the new English text. A further reason for the new edition is the discovery of the original chapter and section headings in Karol Wojtyla's manuscript, which would later (after his election) be delivered by John Paul II during the Wednesday audiences as the theology of the body."
