"The 2010 MCYM-NA Mid-west Regional Conference was held in Toronto from February 12 to 14. A Regional conference is conducted every year to bring the Malankara youth of the region together. Midwest region includes the youth from Chicago, Detroit, and Toronto, a total of around 40 youth attended this conference as well as Saji Achen (Vicar of the Chicago Mission), and Koshy Achen (Vicar of the Detroit Mission). The conference was also blessed with the presence of His Excellency Most Rev. Dr. Joseph Mar Thomas. The conference began with a prayer meeting on Friday at Mr. John Thomas's residence. Most of the Toronto youth attended the prayer and it was a great start for the 2010 regional conference.

The theme of this conference was Theology of the Body. The topic was covered extensively by the GSML ministry on Saturday and they were effective in conveying the message. Theology of the Body is based on the series of 129 lectures given by Pope John Paul II. GSML Ministry provided a condensed version of the Pope's teachings. Throughout the day, the youth were involved in various discussions and activities that helped them understand the different issues that were brought up. In the evening, the Holy Mass was celebrated by His Excellency Most Rev. Dr. Joseph Mar Thomas.

The conference came to an end on Sunday with the Holy Mass, celebrated by Koshy Achen. After lunch, the youth from Chicago and Detroit started their journey back home with a greater understanding of the Theology of the Body. The conference was made a success through the efforts of the youth, parents and especially Daiju Achen. It was wonderful to see the community come together to help organize the 2010 regional conference."

We are caught in the grip of a sexual revolution. Promulgated in everything from film to literature, from music to advertising, sex is an industry pushing relentlessly forward – and leaving a wide path of broken hearts, broken relationships, and broken souls in its wake. Deeply wounded by misguided ideas of sex and the human body and aching with a desire that can't be named, the human heart cries out for answers: What do I live for? What is this burning desire inside? Is there healing? Can I find satisfaction? Will I ever find what I'm looking for?

As the first major teaching of his pontificate, Pope John Paul II sought to answer these questions in a series of 129 papal audiences given from September 1979 to November 1984, which he entitled Theology of the Body. These short talks were the nucleus of a new sexual revolution – reorienting the human desire for love, redefining what it means to be created male and female in the image and likeness of God, and placing our understanding of the body and sexual union into the perspective of the Gospel, the Bible, and the whole of Christ's mission on earth. Papal biographer George Weigel called Theology of the Body a "theological time bomb set to go off with dramatic consequences, sometime in the third millennium of the Church".

If the Theology of the Body is a theological time bomb, then Christopher West – internationally-renowned lecturer, prolific writer, research fellow at the Theology of the Body Institute, and devoted family man – is lighting the fuse. Dynamic, engaging, and deeply moving, West combines a profound reverence for the faith, an infectious enthusiasm, a deep knowledge of pop culture, and his own experiences as a husband and father to convey the richness of John Paul II's study of human sexuality to a level that is exciting, easy to understand, and that strikes home – intellectually, emotionally, and spiritually.

"Toward a Theology of the Suffering Body - by José Granados

There is a chapter of John Paul II's *Theology of the Body* that is still waiting to be written. This claim might be borne out by way of a statement from the author himself, who mentioned at least one aspect of his work that would be worthy of development: "These reflections do not include multiple problems which, with regard to their object, belong to the theology of the body (as, for example, the problem of suffering and death, so important in the biblical message)."¹ Suffering and death are especially important when we try to understand the redemption of the body brought about by Christ. Now, let us remember that the catecheses are arranged according to a temporal pattern: from creation, to historical man (fallen and redeemed), to the resurrection of the body, that is, the last stage of history. This means that the missing chapter in question is the one that would make the transition between the fallen and redeemed states of mankind: the very life and death of Christ, the exact moment and way in which the redemption of the body—and its renewed access to the original experiences of Paradise—took place. ... to read the rest of the article go to www.communio-icr.com/articles/PDF/granados33-4.pdf



Points to Ponder

Who can forget the days that followed April 2, 2005? There was the outpouring of emotion the world over for Pope John Paul II with cries of "SANTO SABITO!" (Sainthood Now!).

The Holy Father often spoke of a "Culture of Death", a culture that looks to death for resolution to life's problems. For John Paul II, this wasn't a philosophical or abstract idea, this was a reality for him growing up in Poland. As a young man, he would have witnessed his friends being taken away to the Concentration Camps, and no doubt would have lived in fear that the same thing could have happened to him had his clandestine priestly studies ever been revealed to the German authorities. After all of this, he lived through Communism in Poland until being elected to the Papacy on October 16, 1978. The tragedies that shaped Pope John Paul II's life taught him about the dignity of the human person, something he preached about throughout his papacy.

Now, almost 5 years later, the cries for sainthood continue throughout the Church. The true 'Miracle' of John Paul II's life would be if everyone who cried for sainthood at his funeral also cried out for the dignity of man, and cried out for a "Culture of Life". The cries would include, the cries to end abortion, cries to end the abuse caused by the use of artificial contraception, and cries to respect the God given differences in the sexes.

The "Theology of the Body" portrays John Paul II's vision of the human person, and the dignity that comes along with being created in the image and likeness of God! Let us pray for the canonization of our beloved Holy Father, but let us also pray for what he wanted the most, a "Culture of Life"!
