The God, Sex and the Meaning of Life team were invited to be the feature presentors at the Couples for Christ Foundation for Family and Life Confrence which was held on the Thanksgiving weekend. There were approximately 190 participants, and the feedback was very positive.

Points to Ponder

The Holy Father Pope John Paul II says the body is a theology and in and through the body we experience Christ (the sacraments).

Why do we struggle to believe the body is holy, and why did Adam and Eve use fig leaves (cover the body) if this is really true?

The entrance of fig leaves was not intended to hide the body because it's somehow 'bad'. The entrance of the fig leaves signifies the intrinsic goodness of the body. We cover the body to protect ourselves from the lust of others, because deep down we all know that lust can never replace love.

So why do we struggle with believing the body is so holy? Our culture 'teaches' us so many false messages about the body, including the ideal shape / size, and that message is all around us. It's easy to get confused, especially when the message of truth is contrary to what we see and hear every day in the mainstream media.
