Points to Ponder

On June 19, 2009, His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI declared the "The Year of The Priest", which concludes on June 19, 2010, (Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus). This year is meant to be a time of prayer for the sanctification and renewal of the clergy. During his announcement, the Holy Father reiterated the church's teachings on the male celibate priesthood.

So why would the Pope call for prayers for the renewal of the clergy, and at the same time remind the faithful that this calling is only for the celibate male? To some this may seem like a contradiction, or Rome simply being 'stuck in its ways'.

In a culture fixated on sex, the celibate vocation in general, not just the priestly vocation,, is even more important. The celibate vocation is meant to remind the non-celibate that there is a greater love than the love expressed by man and wife in the 'One Flesh Union'. So what is this love that's greater than the love of man and wife? The Love of God! In other words, the celibate priesthood opposes the MTV culture head-on and boldly proclaims that there is more to life than sex!

There are countless references within Sacred Scripture that refer to the Church as the Bride of Christ. In much the same way, the parish priest devotes his life to Christ's bride, the parish. The all male priesthood ensures that a fruitful love exists between the bridegroom and the bride (Christ and His Church).

Like many of the Church's teachings, a full understanding can be achieved within a few paragraphs. We encourage those interested in these topics to attend the upcoming Theology of the Body conference, during which topics such as the celibate priesthood will be discussed in greater detail by Christopher West.
